



The roots of Pey-Bonhomme plunge deep into the best limestone-clay soils of CARS, a small village near BLAYE. Crossed by the local oyster beds, Château Pey-Bonhomme-Les-Tours form Bordeaux's most extensive biodynamically-grown vineyard complex, drawing on the "world of living matter" in an approach that differs greatly from that of the industrial reproduction of "dehumanised models". Monitored and certified by the independent organism Ecocert, only natural products are used, with chemical fertilizers, pesticides and herbicides being outlawed, thus preserving the environment for future generations.

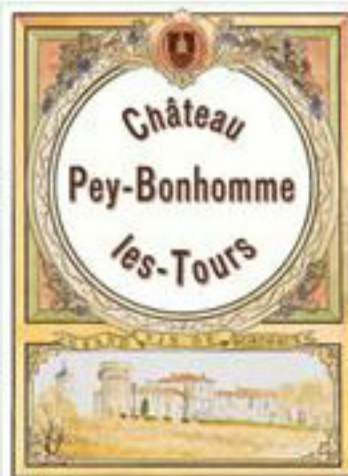
Above all, Pey-Bonhomme embodies a unique and distinctive character and not simply derived from a purely administrative and geographical configuration. The finest establishments in both France and abroad are known to acclaim the wines produced by Chateau Pey-Bonhomme-Les-Tours, which are regularly exported over the world, appearing on the very best dining tables.

Through our efforts in the vineyards, our family seeks to bring out those natural life forces that are necessary for making excellent wines without systematically falling back on technicality. For us, the way forward in tomorrow's world lies in the constant pursuit of a balance between Man and plant. The result is that Pey-Bonhomme offers unique wines described by leading professionals as "ethereal and solar", dominated by redberry fruits combined with a touch of spice.

Pey-Bonhomme is a plump, tender and forward drinking. It's a blend of 75 per cent Merlot, 10 per cent Cabernet Franc, 10 per cent Cabernet Sauvignon and 5 per cent Malbec from limestone and clay hillside plots overlooking the Gironde estuary. The wine is raised in a mixture of concrete and wooden vessels with very little new oak used during the élevage. It's the type of juicy, inky, jolie vin de Bordeaux we produce for years. Beautifully fragrant with juicy black cherry and aromatic incense on the nose, the palate is supple and poised and closes with a mineral/earthy twang, powdery tannins and mouth-cleansing freshness. If it's not the perfect by-the-glass Bordeaux/Merlot, then I must be losing my minds!
